Thank you for submitting the Revised Data Gap Investigation Progress Summary and Soil Vapor Intrusion Status and Recommendations memorandum (memo)¹ in response to the Department of Ecology's (Ecology) November 3 and August 25, 2021, comment letters.² Ecology approves the proposed vapor intrusion assessment work on the Burlington Environmental Property and the Former Potter Property on the condition that the following comment is incorporated:

Attachment E, Port of Tacoma, Former Potter Property, sub-slab sampling and analysis plan: The plan states that differential pressure measurements will be completed at least 72 hours before sub-slab vapor sampling. Please change the plan to incorporate the comment/request in our November 3, 2021, letter that stated that differential pressure measurements will continue through the sample collection period.
