Dear Kyle Waldron:

On February 8, 2022, the Department of Ecology (Ecology) sent you written notice of our preliminary determination that Marathon Petroleum Corporation (Marathon) is a potentially liable person (PLP) for a release of hazardous substances at the Chevron Pipeline Company, Pasco Bulk Terminal facility (Site). On March 14, 2022, the 30-day comment period on our preliminary determination expired. On March 17, 2022, Ecology and Marathon met to discuss the final PLP status for the Site.

Based on the information available during this meeting, Ecology has determined that it will not make a final determination that Marathon Petroleum Corporation is a PLP for a release of hazardous substances at the Site. This determination does not preclude Ecology from later establishing that Marathon Petroleum Corporation is a PLP. This determination is subject to change should additional information be received.
