Dear Julie Peoples:

The Department of Ecology (Ecology) recently received the *Eighth Annual Compliance Groundwater Monitoring Report*, dated January 24, 2022. In the report, Geosyntec Consultants (Geo) recommends reducing the frequency of groundwater monitoring to every other year based on data that suggests the plume has stabilized. Based on Geo's recommendation, you are requesting that the frequency of groundwater monitoring be reduced to every other year.

Ecology has considered your request and approves a groundwater monitoring frequency of every 18 months. Monitoring groundwater every 18 months will provide data that includes monitoring during high and low groundwater events. This frequency will provide sufficient data for our 5-year reviews.
