Description of Proposal: The proposal is for the cleanup of contaminated sediment and soil at the Northport Waterfront site (site). The proposal includes a combination of removing about 13,500 cubic yards of metals contaminated sediment and soil. Excavated areas will be backfilled and remaining metals contaminated material will be capped with imported material consistent with existing sediment.

Location of proposal: Northport, Washington, parcel number 8002673, 48.921 degrees north by -117.77 degrees west.


Proponent: Washington State Department of Ecology
