Subject: Superior Asphalt and Concrete - Amendment to Enforcement Order No. DE 91TC-C444

This letter constitutes the first amendment to Enforcement Order No. DE 91TC-C444 and is issued pursuant to the authority of RCW 70.105D.050(1). The Order is amended to incorporate submittal/construction requirements and schedules for the implementation of the Cleanup Action Plan. Except as specifically mentioned below, all other provisions of this Order continue in effect.

Section IV, Work to be Performed, shall be amended to incorporate the following subsections:

- 4.6 Within sixty (60) calendar days after the effective date of this amendment, Superior Asphalt and Concrete shall submit to Ecology for review and approval an engineering design report in accordance with WAC 173-340-400.
- 4.7 Within sixty (60) calendar days after the effective date of this amendment, Superior Asphalt and Concrete shall submit to Ecology for review and approval the construction plans and specifications in accordance with WAC 173-340-400.
- 4.8 Within sixty (60) calendar days after the effective date of this amendment, Superior Asphalt and Concrete shall submit to Ecology for review and approval a compliance monitoring plan in accordance with WAC 173-340-410.
- 4.9 Within sixty (60) calendar days after the effective date of this amendment, Superior Asphalt and Concrete shall submit to Ecology for review and approval safety and health plan in accordance with WAC 173-340-810.

5.0 Within sixty (60) calendar days after Ecology's approval of the engineering design report, construction plans and specifications, compliance monitoring plan, and the safety and health plan, Superior Asphalt and Concrete shall initiate the cleanup action in accordance with the construction plans and specifications, and related documents.

5.1 Within two and one half (2½) years after initiation of the cleanup action, Superior Asphalt and Concrete shall submit to Ecology for review and approval as-built drawings and a report documenting all aspects of the cleanup action in accordance with WAC 173-340-400.

5.2 Within sixty (60) calendar days after Ecology's approval of the as-built report, Superior Asphalt and Concrete shall execute and record the notarized Restrictive Covenant with the Yakima County Assessor, or other appropriate County entity and shall provide Ecology with a certified true copy of the instrument or its recording reference.
