

PUBLIC NOTICE
Regarding Modifications to the Emerald Services, Inc. Tacoma Facility Dangerous Waste Permit

-- August 2, 2022 —

Emerald Services, Inc. Tacoma Facility (Emerald) has modified the dangerous waste permit for its facility in Tacoma, Washington. In accordance with WAC 173-303-830, the change is a Class 1 modification.

General Facility Operations

The Emerald facility located at 1825 Alexander Ave., Tacoma WA 98421, is a commercial dangerous waste management facility. Treatment processes include solvent and antifreeze recycling, fuel blending, dangerous waste storage, and used oil re-refining. No disposal of dangerous waste occurs on site.

Summary of the Modification

Modification 20: This permit modification will update the General Site Information in Section 2 Table G-1, and the Notification Action Summary in Section 3.1 of the Contingency Plan.
