



Lower Duwamish Waterway (LDW)



- Lead agency for sediment cleanup



- Lead agency for source control



Interim Action

Contaminants of concern:

- Polychlorinated biphenyls (PCBs)
- Carcinogenic polycyclic aromatic hydrocarbons (cPAHs)
- Arsenic




Early cleanup:

- Remove to a minimum depth of 1 – 2 feet of contaminated soil
- Transport off-site to licensed disposal facility
- Backfill dog park area/trail/bioswale with clean soil



Aerial view of Dog Park Project Area


Park Redevelopment

Early 2023

- Ecology addresses comments and finalizes documents

2023

- Complete Interim Action cleanup and off-leash area/trail project

2023 & Beyond...

- Continue site-wide Remedial Investigation and Feasibility Study





