This letter is Ecology's response to the above referenced memorandum, which documents historic groundwater analytical results through May 2022 from monitoring wells on the D Street Petroleum Site. The memorandum proposes changes to the frequency of groundwater sampling from quarterly to semi-annually for monitoring wells B-31, B-25, B-34, HC-111, RW-5R, RW-8, E-22, FW-5R, FW-14, FF-1, RR-2, RR-4, RR-5, T-2, DMW-2, DMW-4 and FW-13. Ecology approves this request for reduced frequency of monitoring of these wells from quarterly to semi-annually.
