RE: Bothell Paint & Decorating Facility Site

Ms. Becker:

Pursuant to Washington State Department of Ecology (Ecology) letter dated August 15, 2022, the City does hereby accept its proposed path forward, with clarifications noted below, in reflection of having satisfactorily completed the Bothell Paint & Decorating Facility Site remedial actions required by Agreed Order No. DE 15748:

- 1) The City requests to terminate and remove the environmental covenant on the City Parcel 0726059054 and 9457200072 (Parcel #3) of the Bothell Paint & Decorating Site (Instrument #20200513000355).
- 2) The City agrees to keep in place the Memorandum of Agreement (MOA), City of Bothell Contract #2277, with Ecology addressing contamination within right of ways.
- 3) The City will decommission wells at the Site (BP-MW-2/2R, BPMW-6, BC-10, BC-11/BC-11R, and BPMW-1) per state regulations, including submitting a NOI (Notice of Intent) and required fees to Ecology's Water Resources Program and following WAC 173-160-460.
- 4) Ecology shall issue a letter on the status of Agreed Order No. DE 15748 to document that no further remedial action is required pursuant to that Agreed Order. The City will continue to undertake actions necessary to control and monitor the remaining contamination within the right of ways pursuant to the MOA.

When notified by Ecology, the City will pursue to completion the activities noted above and understands the Site will not be delisted due to remaining right of way contamination. For any further coordination regarding these matters, I may be contacted at 425.471.1837 or ryan.roberts@bothellwa.gov.
