4	This Declaration of Restrictive Covenant is made pursuant to
5	RCW 70.105D.030(1)(f) and (g) and WAC 173-340-440 by the City of
6	Seattle, its successors and assigns, and the State of Washington
7	Department of Ecology, its successors and assigns (hereafter
8	"Ecology").
9	A remedial action (hereafter "Remedial Action") occurred at
10	the property that is the subject of this Restrictive Covenant.
11	The Remedial Action conducted at the property is described in the
12	following documents: Gas Works Park Environmental Cleanup Final
13	Cleanup Action Plan, June 18, 1999, Prepared by Parametrix Inc.
14	for the City of Seattle and Puget Sound Energy This document is
15	on file at Ecology's Headquarters, 300 Desmond Drive, SE, Lacey

17	This Restrictive Covenant is required because the Remedial
18	Action will result in residual concentrations of Benzo(a)
19	anthracene, Benzo(b)fluoranthene, Benzo(k)fluoranthene,
20	Benzo(a)pyrene, Chrysene, Dibenz(a,h)anthracene, Indeno(1,2,3-
21	cd)pyrene, Naphthalene, Benzene, Ethylbenzene, and Toluene which
22	exceed the Model Toxics Control Act Method B Residential Cleanup
23	Levels for groundwater established under WAC 173-340-720.
24	This Restrictive Covenant is also required because the
25	Remedial Action will result in residual concentrations of
26	Benzo(a) anthracene, Benzo(b) fluoranthene, Benzo(k) fluoranthene,
2.7	Benzo(a)pyrene, Chrysene, Dibenz(a,h)anthracene, Indeno(1,2,3-

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28 cd)pyrene, Naphthalene, Pyrene, Fluoranthene, and Arsenic which

29 exceed the Model Toxics Control Act Method B Residential Cleanup

30 Levels for soil established under WAC 173-340-740.

This Restrictive Covenant is also required because a

32 conditional point of compliance has been established for

33 groundwater.

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The undersigned, The City of Seattle, is the fee owner of

real property (hereafter "Property") in the County of King,

36 State of Washington, that is subject to this Restrictive

37 Covenant. The Property is legally described as follows: [

39 The City of Seattle makes the following declaration as to

40 limitations, restrictions, and uses to which the Property may be

41 put and specifies that such declarations shall constitute

42 covenants to run with the land, as provided by law and shall be

43 binding on all parties and all persons claiming under them,

44 including all current and future owners of any portion of or

interest in the Property (hereafter "Owner").

Any activity on the Property that may result in the 46 release or exposure to the environment of the contaminated 47 soil that was contained as part of the Remedial Action, or 48 create a new exposure pathway, is prohibited. Some examples 49 of activities that are prohibited in the areas beneath the 50 vegetated soil cover include: drilling, digging, placement 51 of any objects or use of any equipment which deforms or 52 stresses the surface beyond its load bearing capability, 53

piercing the surface with a rod, spike or similar item,

- 55 bulldozing or earthwork.
- No groundwater may be taken from the Property for any
- 57 purpose other than remediation.
- 3. A portion of the Property contains Benzo(a) anthracene,
- Benzo(b) fluoranthene, Benzo(k) fluoranthene, Benzo(a) pyrene,
- 60 Chrysene, Dibenz(a,h)anthracene, Indeno(1,2,3-cd)pyrene,
- Naphthalene, Pyrene, Fluoranthene, and Arsenic contaminated
- soil located under the Cracking Towers and Play Barn
- buildings. The Owner shall not alter, modify, or remove the
- existing structure[s] in any manner that may result in the
- release or exposure to the environment of that contaminated
- soil or create a new exposure pathway without prior written
- 67 approval from Ecology.
- 68 4. Any activity on the Property that may interfere with
- the integrity of the Remedial Action and continued
- 70 protection of human health and the environment is
- 71 prohibited.

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- 5. Any activity on the Property that may result in the
- release or exposure to the environment of a hazardous
- substance that remains on the Property as part of the
- 75 Remedial Action, or create a new exposure pathway, is
- 76 prohibited without prior written approval from Ecology.
- 78 The Owner of the property must give thirty (30) day advance
- 79 written notice to Ecology of the Owner's intent to convey any
- 80 interest in the Property. No conveyance of title, easement,
- 81 lease, or other interest in the Property shall be consummated by

- 82 the Owner without adequate and complete provision for continued
- 83 monitoring, operation, and maintenance of the Remedial Action.

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- 85 The Owner must restrict leases to uses and activities consistent
- 86 with the Restrictive Covenant and notify all lessees of the
- 87 restrictions on the use of the Property.

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- 89 The Owner must notify and obtain approval from Ecology prior to
- 90 any use of the Property that is inconsistent with the terms of
- 91 this Restrictive Covenant. Ecology may approve any inconsistent
- 92 use only after public notice and comment.

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- 94 The Owner shall allow authorized representatives of Ecology the
- 95 right to enter the Property at reasonable times for the purpose
- of evaluating the Remedial Action; to take samples, to inspect
- 97 remedial actions conducted at the property, and to inspect
- 98 records that are related to the Remedial Action.

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- 100 The Owner of the Property reserves the right under WAC 173-340-
- 101 440 to record an instrument that provides that this Restrictive
- 102 Covenant shall no longer limit use of the Property or be of any
- 103 further force or effect. However, such an instrument may be
- 104 recorded only if Ecology, after public notice and opportunity for
- 105 comment, concurs.

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
