COMMENTS

One diesel UST was removed from this property in 1990. Characterization samples indicated PCS was present but the excavation was backfilled after removal awaiting for better weather. In 1991, an Ecology II was conducted and indicated that all vehicles were drained before placing in the yard, no soil staining was visible at the site, and that the site is a model operation for a wrecking yard. In August 1991, cleanup of the former UST area was conducted. An undisclosed amount of PCS was overexcavated and

landfarmed on-site. Confirmation soil samples from the excavation and GW were ND for TPH and BTEX. No soil samples from the landfarming were observed in the file and no indication if the treated soil was used as backfill. In 1998, Ecology sent letters to the owners requesting a cleanup report and the owners sent the report again. The final report was stamped as received in 1991. A note of the 1998 cover letter sent with the report copy says "the site status was already "reported cleaned up", so it's unclear why they were sent a letter".
