Farallon and Quarterra Multifamily Communities LLC have been moving forward with the planned cleanup action and redevelopment at the U Village Safeway Property at 3020 Northeast 45th Street in Seattle (expedited VCP No. XN0028). Please see below for a status update on the items listed in the expedited VCP guidance:

- Description and status of Site characterization or cleanup work (completed during past quarter or ongoing work).
 - Farallon currently is conducting a remedial investigation (RI) and feasibility study (FS) at the Property to evaluate the nature and extent of contamination at the Property and evaluate cleanup action alternatives. The findings of Farallon's RI and FS will be presented to Ecology in a Remedial Investigation/Feasibility Study and Cleanup Action Plan (RI/FS-CAP).
- A list of pending opinion requests to Ecology and expected date for next request for Ecology opinion.
 - There are currently no pending opinions from Ecology. Farallon anticipates requesting an opinion from Ecology for the RI/FS-CAP that will be submitted during the next quarter.
- Summary of dates and titles of documents submitted to Ecology for review in the last quarter.
 - No documents were submitted to Ecology for review in the last quarter.
- Type of documents and opinion requests planned for submittal to Ecology during the next quarter.
 - Farallon anticipates submitting a RI/FS-CAP for Ecology's review during the next quarter.

 - Property redevelopment activities are anticipated to begin in early 2024.  - There have been no schedule delays or changes to the cleanup action since the prior quarter.
