This quarterly progress report is being submitted on behalf of the City of Olympia (City) for the Carpenter Road Site (Site). The Site is identified as Carpenter Road Olympia PD Shooting Range in Ecology's database. The Site address is 6530 Martin Way E, Lacey, WA 98516. Ecology's Cleanup Site ID, Facility/Site ID and VCP Project ID are 14692, 50400 and XS0008, respectively. This quarterly progress report is being submitted as a requirement of the Department of Ecology (Ecology) under the Voluntary Cleanup Program (VCP) and is for the quarter comprised of December 2022 through February 2023.

 - A draft letter report presenting the results of the Tacoma Smelter Plume evaluation for the Carpenter Road property was submitted to Ecology on January 10, 2023.
 - The results of the evaluation identified that arsenic and lead concentrations are less than the respective MTCA cleanup levels for unrestricted land use and the TSP Model Remedies Guidance criteria for soil and duff at the property outside of the firing range cleanup Site.
 - Ecology provided concurrence with the results of the Tacoma Smelter Plume evaluation in an email on January 10, 2023.
 - A final Carpenter Road Tacoma Smelter Plume evaluation letter report was submitted for Ecology's file on January 15, 2023.
 - Engineering design and preparation of construction plans and specifications is being performed.
- A list of pending opinion requests to Ecology and expected date for next request for Ecology opinion.
 - The City will be requesting an NFA letter from Ecology following the completion of the cleanup action in accordance with the NFA likely letter.
