Documents ready for public review and comment

Ecology negotiated a legal agreement called an Agreed Order with Bridge Point Seattle 130 LLC (Bridge Point), the Potentially Liable Person (PLP), for the Dawn Food Products cleanup site (Site) at 6901 Fox Avenue South in Seattle. The Agreed Order requires the PLP to address contamination at the Site. We would like your input on the following documents:

- Agreed Order: legal document that requires Bridge Point to investigate environmental conditions, complete a Remedial Investigation (RI), Feasibility Study (FS), and a draft Cleanup Action Plan (dCAP).
- **Public Participation Plan**: describes how Ecology will inform the community about site activities and ways to become involved.


Toxics Cleanup Program



Site Background

The Dawn Food Products cleanup site is located at 6901 Fox Avenue South in Seattle WA. Bridge Point Seattle 130 LLC recently purchased the approximately 5.4-acre property in the industrial area near Seattle's Georgetown neighborhood in 2021. This property is located adjacent to the Lower Duwamish Waterway (LDW) Superfund Site.

Historical evidence indicates that the property has been used since at least 1917 for various commercial and industrial uses including

ship building, sheet metal fabrication and generator manufacturing, electric thermostat manufacturing, paint spraying, general storage, and offices. Ship building operations occurred primarily in the southwestern portion of the property. Roughly seven structures were removed and replaced with the existing warehouse in 1977. The existing structure is approximately 128,800 square feet (2.96 acres), in which dry foods and cooking oils are currently stored. The warehouse has been used by multiple food companies over the decades.

Contamination

Investigations through 2021 found the following contaminants of concern in soils and groundwater on the property:

- Metals
- Total petroleum hydrocarbons (TPH) from gasoline
- Carcinogenic Polycyclic Aromatic Hydrocarbons (cPAHs)
- Halogenated solvents



Why this site matters

The Dawn Food Products site is adjacent to the <u>Lower</u> <u>Duwamish Waterway</u>¹ Superfund Site, which includes a 5mile stretch of the Duwamish River. The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) added the <u>LDW Superfund Site</u>² to the Superfund National Priorities List in 2001. Ecology is working to stop or reduce sources of contamination to the LDW Superfund Site, an effort known as "<u>source control</u>³," so that the EPA can proceed with the cleanup of the river sediment.

What happens next?


Ecology will consider all comments received during this public comment period and may make changes to the Agreed Order or Public Participation Plan. If the documents require significant changes, we will hold another public comment period.

If no significant changes are made, Ecology will finalize the documents and the PLP will proceed with the Remedial Investigation, Feasibility Study, and create a Draft Cleanup Action Plan for public review.

Each of those steps will require a public comment period. The graphic below shows these different stages of cleanup. Sometimes multiple stages occur in one public comment period.

Ecology's cleanup process

The Model Toxics Control Act (<u>MTCA</u>⁴) is Washington's environmental cleanup law. It provides requirements for contaminated site cleanup and sets standards that protect human health and the environment. Ecology implements the <u>MTCA cleanup process</u>⁵ and oversees cleanups.
