Thank you for working with the Washington State Department of Ecology (Ecology) on the Gold Knob Prospects Site). This letter provides written notification that the remedial actions required by Agreed Order No. DE 15823¹ have been satisfactorily completed and that no further remedial action is necessary to clean up contamination at the Site under the Model Toxics Control Act (MTCA), Chapter 70.105D RCW.² The Order became effective on October 25, 2018 and was amended on April 28, 2020.³

Satisfaction of Order

Ecology has determined the requirements of the Order have been satisfied. Ecology made this determination pursuant to Section IX (Satisfaction of Order).

The remedial actions required by the Order are specified in Section VII (Work to Be Performed). The City of Wenatchee was required to remove and properly dispose of waste rock piles containing arsenic and metals at concentrations above MTCA cleanup levels. After inspecting the Site and reviewing the supporting documentation, Ecology has determined that the remedial actions required by the Order have been satisfactorily completed.
