  - King County Parks transmitted the legislative package to Council on January 3, 2023, with
    the Agreed Order Amendment. Council is reviewing the package, which is evidenced by
    questions they have sent to Lindsey, but it has gotten pushed back on their agenda twice
    for discussion. It is currently scheduled to be discussed on the June 27 agenda.
  - Parks will be sending Annual Monitoring Report covering the period from June 2021 to May 2022 this week.
  - Parks also drafted the Annual Monitoring Report for the period covering June 2022 May 2023 and should be able to send that by the end of May 2023.
  - Parks is finishing setting up the solar well pump to provide water for the 3 acres of revegetation area planted last year.
