Dear Jim Cach:

This letter is a reminder that under Agreed Order DE 15389,¹ the Department of Ecology (Ecology) requires that all environmental data must be electronically entered into our Environmental Information Management (EIM)² system. As of August 8, 2023, there have been no submittals of data to EIM under the existing agreed order.

The Toxics Cleanup Program Policy 840³ (Data Submittal Requirements) is incorporated in Section VIII, Subsection E of the agreed order. The policy states that environmental data must be entered into EIM at the time of report submittal. If electronic submittal has not been completed, then any report submittal can be deemed incomplete, and the review of that report may be put on hold.
