
C.D. Stimson Company (Stimson) is in receipt of your letter dated August 19, 2013 requesting information regarding the status of the above referenced VCP project. By this letter, Stimson is hereby terminating the VCP Agreement governing Project No. NW2354. The Project involved the cleanup of the Salmon Bay Center facility (Site). This notice is being provided in accordance with the terms of the Agreement. Based on that Agreement, Stimson understands that:

1. The effective date of termination will be the date Ecology receives this letter.
2. Stimson remains responsible for any costs incurred by Ecology under the Agreement before the effective date of termination.

Stimson's entry into the VCP program was at the request of City of Seattle Department of Planning and Development as part of the permitting for a proposed redevelopment of the Site. The proposed redevelopment has been delayed indefinitely and as a consequence no VCP-related activities are currently being conducted or anticipated in the near future.
