1) Utility vault conflict with stormdrain line connecting to existing catch basin @ Chestnut -Tyson will consider adding another catch basin between CB#3 and the existing catch basin

to re-align the pipe run to mitigate the conflict.

2) Soils in the engineered drainage structure are under water and/or too wet to run equipment over and place gravel cover - work sink significantly. IOEI will look into triaxial geotextiles and other alternatives to place over the saturated materials that can support the gravel cover.

3) Trenches contain water - specs call for backfilling trenches with cut soil material from the parcels, but with the water in the trenches, the soil materials would liquefy and not be suitable as backfill - recommend placing 4"-8" spalls in the trenches to above the water level (average 2' throughout the trenches) to provide stable platform for backfill above the water level and gravel cover.

Six stockpiles areas were set up - 2 adjacent to each excavation area (1 for overburden and 1 for contaminated soil/material for each respective excavation) - the stockpiles were lined with 10-mil poly sheeting within 1 foot soil berms and covered with 6-mil reinforced poly sheeting secured with sand bags.

Bid line item 14 for select excavation indicates a quantity of 55 cubic yards. Measured cubic yards for the select excavations per the specifications and plans, and as excavated:

 $4.5' \times 10' \times 10' = 450 \text{ cft/}27 = 16.67 \text{ bank cyds}$ $7.5' \times 10' \times 10' = 750 \text{ cft/}27 = 27.78 \text{ bank cyds}$ $9.5' \times 10' \times 10' = 950 \text{ cft/}27 = 35.18 \text{ bank cyds}$ = 79.63 bank cubic yards of select excavation.

Delays or Issues that Affected Progress:

the 4.5' and 7.5' excavations were completed - during the 9.5' excavation the 3" trash pump broke and the 2" trash pump was having difficulty dewatering the excavation due to the intake clogging with wood debris. The 9.5' excavation was suspended until Monday when a replacement 3" trash pump could be mobilized to the site for dewatering.

Shoring for the 7.5' and 9.5' excavations was mobilized to the site, however, due to concrete foundation obstructions within both of these excavations, the shoring could not be installed in either of these excavations. Due to the proximity of the 7.5' excavation to existing utilities and Jefferson Street, this excavation was backfilled with quarry spalls to 3' below ground surface to prevent additional sloughing of soils to protect the utilities, sidewalk and street.
