I provide this letter as General Counsel to the Spokane Airport Board (the "Airport"). I will also serve as the primary contact on this matter. Pursuant to our meeting on November 1, 2023, I respectfully request a 60-day extension to further negotiate an agreed order and related scope of work in the above-referenced matter. The Airport has been diligently reviewing the terms of the agreed order proposed by the Department of Ecology.

The 60-day extension is necessary to obtain technical and expert review and analyses of your proposed scope of work. To that end, the Airport has been diligently working to interview and procure qualified consultants necessary to define and carry out a science-based, collaborative scope of work under an agreed order. Once the Airport procures the necessary consultants in accordance with the Airport's procurement requirements, we will work with them to provide a revised scope of work for your review and consideration.
