## MARALCO ALUMINUM SITE UPDATED PUBLIC PARTICIPATION PLAN

The Washington Department of Ecology (Ecology) is committed to providing public participation opportunities during the investigation and cleanup of hazardous waste sites. The public participation plan is intended to promote public understanding of Ecology's responsibilities, planning and remedial activities at hazardous waste sites. It also provides an opportunity for Ecology to receive information from the public that will enable the department to develop a comprehensive cleanup plan protective of both human health, and the environment.

The following public participation activities for the remedial investigation at the Maralco Aluminum Site (7730 South 202nd Street, Kent, WA 98032) are based on information gathered during April 1990. The names of individuals contacted are included in the attached Mailing List, along with other individuals and groups identified as having interest in the site.

Public participation for the Maralco Aluminum Site shall consist of the following activities:

 A 30-day public comment period for the Public Participation Plan, and the Phase I work-plan beginning June 15, 1990 and ending July 15, 1990.
