Landau Associates, Inc. (Landau) prepared this progress report for the TECT Aerospace Cleanup site (Site), at the request of the Snohomish County Airport (Airport), to address Snohomish County's obligation under Section VII (C) of Agreed Order No. DE 21781 (AO) to provide progress reports to the Washington State Department of Ecology (Ecology). This report summarizes progress during the third quarter (July through September) of 2023, and activities anticipated for the fourth quarter (October through December) of 2023.

The following activities were conducted in the third quarter of 2023:

- Finalization and execution of the AO on August 30, 2023.
- Ongoing coordination with waste disposal vendors to characterize and dispose of existing investigation-derived waste drums currently stored on Site.
- Management and implementation of groundwater sampling of monitoring wells installed during pre-AO Site investigation activities, including coordination with the Airport, tenants, the analytical laboratory, and Ecology. Groundwater sampling was conducted on September 26, 2023.
- Internal planning and preparation of cumulative Site data tables and figures to be included in the Remedial Investigation/Feasibility Study (RI/FS) Work Plan (RI/FS Work Plan).

The following activities are anticipated for the fourth quarter of 2023:

- Conduct a key project meeting with Ecology, Airport, and Landau project teams to discuss goals of the RI/FS and requirements outlined in the AO.
- Data management related to 3Q23 groundwater sampling, including data validation, tabulation, and quality control assessments.

- Communicate results of 3Q23 groundwater sampling to Ecology.
- Ongoing preparation of Airport and Ecology RI/FS Work Plan drafts.

Deviations from the AO Scope of Work and Schedule:

• None to report.
