Cleanup Status Report Technical Memo Summary

This technical memo documents the progress at the Alatheia Riding Center site regarding their active Voluntary Cleanup Progam (VCP) application with the Department of Ecology (Ecology); VCP Project No. CE0539, Cleanup Site No. 16661, Facility/Site No. 99997706. A letter was received by the applicant from Ecology dated January 25, 2024 requesting an update on the status of the project, along with the submittal of any completed reports, and a plan and schedule for completing the cleanup (Attachment A). All relevant information is included below.

Cleanup Status

The Alatheia Riding Center project is still in process. Following project enrollment in the VCP and receipt of an Opinion Letter from Ecology on October 20, 2022, the applicant submitted a SEPA checklist to Chelan County in January of 2023 as part of a Conditional Use Permit (CUP) application. The CUP 23-159 was granted on June 13, 2023. Following issuance of the CUP, the CSGP Permit No. WAR312616 was issued and all required reporting has been conducted on schedule. Grading work was started. Work was put on hold in the early fall due to a lack of excavation and grading equipment availability. The site was winterized and will remain dormant until moisture conditions allow reinitiation of construction starting in late February through March of 2024.

Cleanup Reports

No additional reports have been completed at this time. The applicant submitted the Remedial Action Plan (RAP) to Ecology during enrollment in the VCP and received an Opinion Letter, as described above. Upon project completion, a Remedial Action Report (RAR) will be submitted to Ecology documenting how the project implemented the Model Remedies for former orchard lands consistent with Ecology publication 21-09-006 *Model Remedies for Cleanup of Former Orchard Properties in Central and Eastern Washington July 2021* and the submitted RAP. The RAR will include compliance monitoring data, photo documentation of implementation, and any soil testing lab results. At that time, Ecology will be asked to prepare an Environmental Covenant for the property pursuant to the Model Toxics Control Act (MTCA) chapter 70.105D RCW and the Uniform Environmental Covenants Act (UECA) chapter 64.70 RCW and issue a No Further Action letter.

Plan and Schedule for Completing the Cleanup

It is expected that site grading and excavation will commence as soon as moisture conditions allow reinitiation of construction. The anticipated start work date is the end of February through beginning of March 2024. It is anticipated that construction of the hard and soft caps, and compliance monitoring will occur throughout the spring and into the summer, with an estimated project completion date in the of fall of 2024. It is expected that a Remedial Action Report (RAR) will be submitted to Ecology at the close of the project in early winter of 2024, with an expected

date of project close-out with the VCP program following Ecology preparation of the necessary Environmental Covenant occurring in early spring of 2025.

Conclusion

The Alatheia Riding Center VCP project remains active. Site preparation activities occurred throughout 2023 including the receipt of necessary permitting and site preparation. The project was put on hold in the early fall due to a lack of equipment availability and the onset of inclement winter weather. It is anticipated that site work will resume at the end of February through March of 2024. Remediation work including the construction of hard and soft caps, and compliance testing will occur throughout the spring and summer, with an expected Remedial Action Report submittal to Ecology occurring in late fall of 2024.
