- Description and status of Site characterization or cleanup work (completed during past quarter or ongoing work). AEG advanced additional off-property wells during the week of 9/25/23. New wells MW-8 through MW-14 are illustrated on the latest version of the Site Map (attached). Soil data from these borings is also attached in Table 1. All results were ND. Two proposed wells to define impacts to the west across N Alder St (Hwy 101) were unable to be installed due to the presence of a gas line adjacent to the proposed locations, and AEG was not prepared (and did not have approval from WSDOT) to close a lane of traffic, which was needed to get them installed. Instead, AEG just received approval from the client to pursue access to the residential property across the street to see if the wells could be installed in the grass area adjacent the residence. Access is pending.

Next quarter, AEG hopes to get the remaining two wells installed, then sample all new & existing wells. The data will then be included in an RIFS Report to be submitted to Ecology for review/opinion.
