Dear Carson Welch:

The Department of Ecology (Ecology) received the Colville Tributary Fish Barrier Removal-Soil Chemical Analytical Results, November 21, 2023, indicating a release of potentially hazardous substances. We have investigated the release, or threatened release of hazardous substances to identify impacts to human health and the environment, as required under Chapter 70A.305 Revised Code of Washington (RCW)¹, based on the observations and information provided during the site visit.

Ecology maintains a database of known or suspected contaminated sites that will need remedial actions to meet requirements established under the <u>Model Toxics Control Act</u> (MTCA),² Chapter 70A.305 RCW, and <u>173-340 WAC</u>.³ This state law sets the requirements necessary to clean up contaminated sites that can threaten human health and the environment.

During the investigation, Ecology determined that contamination exists at your site. As a result, we added this property to our database as a state cleanup site that will need to be cleaned up pursuant to MTCA requirements. Ecology assigned a cleanup site ID number (CSID No) 17010. You can find site information and electronic records for this site on the cleanup site webpage⁴

This letter or inclusion in our database of state cleanup sites does not mean that Ecology has made a determination about potential liability for cleanup under MTCA. Ecology's policy is to work cooperatively with individuals to accomplish prompt and effective cleanups.

Ecology's <u>Voluntary Cleanup Program</u> (VCP)⁵ provides technical assistance and opinions on the sufficiency of independent remedial actions. You can determine your site's eligibility and apply for the program by completing the <u>Agency Determination Checklist</u>,⁶ available at <u>our</u> webpage.

Ecology likely will require a more detailed investigation in the future if an independent remedial action does not occur on this property. Investigation typically consists of additional testing for contamination, including soil and groundwater sampling.
