Washington Department of Ecology's (Ecology) Toxics Cleanup program appreciates your participation in the additional site assessment completed by GeoEngineers on December 12 and 13, 2024 at the WA DOT Anatone Maintenance Site in Anatone, Washington. Attached is GeoEngineers *Environmental Site Assessment – WSDOT Anatone Maintenance Facility Technical Memorandum* detailing the results of the site assessment.

The purpose of the site assessment was to further characterize the previously identified petroleum impacts at the former LUST site to provide a No Further Action (NFA) determination. Based upon the results of the site characterization, residual petroleum contaminated soil remains at the site below Washington State Model Toxics Control Act (MTCA) Method A cleanup levels for unrestricted land use. Based on the results of the site assessment, Ecology has determined that the release(s) of petroleum in soil at the subject site does not pose a substantial threat to human health or the environment.

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Therefore, Ecology is issuing a NFA determination under the Model Toxics Control Act (MTCA)¹.

This NFA determination is made only for releases identified in the independent remedial action report(s) associated with the LUST and applies only to the area(s) of the property affected by those releases. The NFA does not apply to any other release or potential release at the property, any other areas on the property, nor any other properties owned or operated by Washington Department of Transportation (WSDOT).

Because your actions were not conducted under a consent decree this letter is offered as informal assistance and advice² and does not constitute a MTCA settlement³, therefore this NFA determination is not binding on Ecology. Should additional information indicate that further action under MTCA is necessary, Ecology may re-evaluate the site.
