Boeing Auburn Cleanup

What's going on?

Boeing is cleaning up groundwater contamination in Algona, near their Auburn facility. You may see large equipment installing groundwater monitoring wells. This work may be noisy but won't last long.

The wells are needed to inject food for the natural bacteria that break down the contamination. The bacteria food is a milky-white fluid made from vegetable oil. It's completely safe for humans and pets.

When to expect it

May 2024: Wells will be installed in the Algona commercial district.

Early June 2024: A well will be installed in the Algona residential area.

July & August 2024: You may see workers near the wells. They will be injecting the bacteria food or taking samples.
