Hi Suzy,

Thanks for responding to our comments. The phased analysis approach is reasonable for this investigation. However, please include the following in your sampling and analysis plan:

- **FB-11**: if analyzing any samples for GRO, please also analyze for BTEX regardless of whether GRO is detected; also analyze the samples for DRO and ORO to provide more information on contaminant distribution in this area (based on detections at PH-11A, TP-7, and TP-17).
- **FB-12**: analyze the samples for BTEX regardless of whether GRO is detected; BTEX needs to be evaluated in this area due to its close proximity to PH-12 where GRO was previously elevated but no BTEX data had been collected.
- **FB-13**: analyze the samples for BTEX regardless of whether GRO is detected.
- **FB-15**: analyze the samples for naphthalenes and lead in addition to the other compounds listed.
- **FB-16**: analyze the samples for cadmium and lead if they are detected at FB-15.
