Dear Christer:

This Progress Report has been prepared by Aspect Consulting (Aspect) for the District on the River Redevelopment at the Hamilton Street Bridge site (Site) as a requirement of Prospective Purchaser Consent Decree (PPCD) No. 21200059-32 between Sagamore Spokane, LLC (Sagamore) and the Washington State Department of Ecology (Ecology). The PPCD was signed and executed on January 15, 2021. Section XII of the PPCD requires Sagamore to submit to Ecology a written monthly Progress Report that describes the PPCD-required actions completed during the reporting period. This Progress Report No. 34 covers the reporting period of May 1 through May 31, 2024.

# 1) Progress During Reporting Period

Progress and actions taken at the Site during this period include:

- Monthly Progress Report No. 33 (April 2024) was transmitted to Ecology on May 15, 2024.
- May 3, 2024 Ecology Site Visit and Email. Ecology's concern related to downed fencing and trespassing and a tent along the riverbank.
  - Sagamore responded on May 3 and 9 with actions taken by the private security firm subcontracted to Sagamore (see attached email).
- May 29, 2024 Ecology Site Visit and Email and Sagamore response on May 30. Ecology's concern related to downed fencing.
  - After the May 3 fence and trespassing issue, Sagamore coordinated with Spokane Police Department who is making courtesy visits to the Site and asking trespassers to leave. They did this on May 29. Sagamore sent Ecology an email on May 30 documenting this action (see attached email). Additionally, the private security company continues to make weekly visits and Sagamore coordinated with a fence repair company to fix the fence.
  - As stated previously, a discussion appears warranted to reestablish cleanup goals and objectives regarding the trespassing situation along the riverbank.
- The one remaining stockpile remains appropriately covered and secured.
  - Stormwater Discharges from the Hamilton Street Bridge. On February 18, 2024, Christer Loftenius and Dave Cook (Aspect) discussed the Hamilton Street Bridge

stormwater discharges onto (and ponding within) the Sagamore property. We understand that Ecology is communicating with the Washington State Department of Transportation (WSDOT) regarding fixing, repairing, and managing stormwater from the bridge.

• Sagamore was informed by WSDOT during May that they will be working to fix the bridge seal and drainage issue during June.

• No soil or groundwater samples were obtained for testing during this reporting period.

# 6) List of Deliverables and Key Activities Planned for Next Month

• Sagamore indicates that building design has been changed by eliminating one of the two buildings along MLK. The updated project design still needs to be approved by City of Spokane design commission. Construction will not start until after city of Spokane building department redesign approval is obtained in 2024. A revised construction schedule will be included in the EDR Amendment transmitted to Ecology if/when this change is finalized.

What I understand is that Securitas called the City of Spokane's 311 homeless/trespasser/crime check support number on May 3 to report the trespasser; then followed up on May 6. Today, May 9, they visited the site again and the tent was still on the site. Securitas' representative was able to confront the trespasser and got them to move.

Hi Chris. Thanks for your vmail and email. Also appreciated our phone conversation this afternoon. Here's a followup.

I called James Kopsho, District Manager of Securitas, Sagamore's subcontracted security company. James visited the site yesterday and sent his report this afternoon (see attached). He observed the tent that you observed. It appears that the tent and trespasser moved-in sometime this week between Securitas' security check last week and the visit yesterday. Here's what Securitas does, and did in this instance:

- 1. Called Spokane Crime Check (509.456.2233). They spoke with a dispatcher who notifies Spokane Police Dept. to respond.
- 2. James said that this is a non-emergency response, but SPD does eventually make a site visit. James indicated that he requests that SPD call Securitas and then they meet SPD on site. The site meeting hasn't happened yet.
- 3. James also said that he actually confronted the trespasser yesterday and issued him a no trespass notice (I wasn't familiar with this process, but Securitas and apparently citizens have the right to issue such notices to vacate private property).
- 4. If the trespasser returns, then Securitas can provide a record of the no trespass notice to the individual and SPD which may help to have trespassers leave the premises.
- 5. I talked to James about the fence and this is going to be a difficult thing to maintain. Fences are too easy to cut, move, or disassemble. The fence is not a long term solution. However, the weekly security checks seem to be the best solution to keep long term camping off the property.
- 6. You mentioned to me about developing another solution to prevent trespassers from potentially damaging the river bank. In the last monthly report to Ecology, we acknowledged the necessity for an alternative or at least a "re-think" of the past remedial action adopted under the Agreed Order to address this part of the site.

You wanted to contact the City to express Ecology's concerns. The phone number in item 1 is probably the best place to start. They should be aware of the issue based on Securitas' notification. You also asked me about the construction schedule and updating the Engineering Design Report. I indicated that we know that we need to update the EDR, but that this will be done once the new redevelopment design is approved by the City at which point a construction schedule will be established. You'll need to talk with Sagamore directly for any additional information related to these plans and timeframes. Dave

Hi Dave:

I went for a Site visit this Wed. The construction area seems to be in good shape: the fence surrounding the construction area had not been breached, and the remaining soil stockpile was still covered and secure.

However, there is no fence blocking entrance to the riverbank on the west side of the Site (the panels have been thrown to the side). There was at least one tent pitched along the riverbank and there is sign of damage to the riverbank where the fence used to be. What are Sagamore's s plans to secure the riverbank?

Secondly, when can Ecology expect to receive the revised EDR containing the revised building foundation method and an updated detailed construction schedule?
