## Dear Ben Kleban:

On June 18, 2024, the Washington Department of Ecology (Ecology) issued an Enforcement Order (EO) that requires Stillwater Holdings LLC (SWH) to complete Emergency Interim Actions at the Stillwater Holdings Chevron (Site). Ecology issued this EO pursuant to the Model Toxics Control Act, RCW 70A.305.050(1).

On August 12, 2024, Ecology requested that Stillwater Holdings provide a document that outlines plans to clean up the site pursuant to the EO by August 23, 2024. Ecology has not received any communication from Stillwater Holdings in response to the EO.

As stated in several communications and in the EO, the current and immediate threat to human health and the environment is the contaminated groundwater in the sumps of the Marcus Whitman Hotel (MWH) and 106 Building and the associated vapor intrusion to these buildings.

Ecology has not received a written response to our August 12, 2024 letter. Stillwater Holdings LLC is not in compliance with the EO. Pursuant to RCW 70A.305.050 the Attorney General may bring an action to enforce the EO in state court per the terms in Paragraph 11 of the EO.
