Farallon anticipates the start date for the cleanup excavation in fourth quarter 2024 after receiving the approval of the Construction Stormwater General Permit from Ecology.

 Excavation of contaminated soil at Thompson field scheduled for the summer 2024 has been delayed pending the issuance of the Construction Stormwater General Permit from Ecology. The permit is anticipated to be issued within 90-120 days.
