This quarterly progress report summarizes completed work and upcoming work at Yakima County Public Services' closed Snipes Mountain Landfill (Snipes Landfill) located in the vicinity of 1150 Luther Road, Sunnyside, WA 98944 (Facility site ID: 501; Cleanup Site ID: 3402) as required by the Agreed Order (DE 22514).

During the last quarter, between June 20 and September 20, 2024, the following activities have occurred and work has been performed:

- 1. We submitted the Revised Data Summary Report to the Washington Department of Ecology (Ecology) on July 31, 2024. Ecology accepted the report on August 19, 2024.
- 2. We met with Ecology to discuss Draft Remedial Investigation (RI) work plan elements on August 1, 2024.
- 3. We submitted the agency review draft RI work plan to Ecology on August 30, 2024.
- 4. RI/FS quarterly groundwater and routine landfill gas monitoring per WAC 173-304-490 was conducted the week of August 26, 2024.
 - Downloaded Solinst Levelogger unvented water-level transducer data from site monitoring wells SMW-4, SMW-5s, and SMW-5d and barometer data. Weekly manual measurements are collected at SMW-1.
- 5. During the week of July 22nd, the following offsite well water samples were collected and analyzed for VOCs:
 - o 2520 Gap Road
 - o 2610 Gap Road
 - o OL Luther
 - DNR House (Evans)

Results letters were sent to each property owner the week of September 3, 2024 and are attached to this update letter.

During the next quarter, from September 20 to December 20, 2024, the following work is anticipated:

- 1. Revise and resubmit the RI work plan to Ecology.
- 2. Fourth Quarter groundwater monitoring.
- 3. Continue with RI work plan tasks
