Ecology has received three complaints regarding this property.

In July 2023, a new property manager notified Ecology that the tenant had been illegally changing oil on the property, dumping oil to pavement, grass, and into the storm drain in the driveway.

In August 2023, a nearby resident (of the Water Gardens community) notified Ecology that there is a steel fabrication welding shop at this location, that is zoned residential. Paint fumes come into the neighborhood due to doors open during the day. The house is rented out to individuals that flip cars. There is grease everywhere, and oil on pavement has gone into storm/wastewater system.

In February 2024 another resident of Water Gardens community submitted a letter to multiple agencies regarding similar complaints.

The City of Maple Valley confirmed during inspection that the tenant had been working on vehicles, dumping vehicle fluids down a private catch basin leading to an infiltration pipe under the driveway. The City issued a warning letter to the property owner, requiring removal of all hazardous materials from the property, and soil testing. An additional warning letter was sent, requiring the owner complete soil cleanup, disposal, and retesting prior to January 6, 2024, to avoid fines.

In April 2024, Ecology contacted the City, inquiring about progress on the cleanup and enforcement. Cleanup had not progressed.

In June 2024, the City contacted NWRO TCP regarding potential enforcement and assistance with compliance at the property. The City has attempted to work with the property owner to achieve cleanup of impacted soil, but the owner and/or tenant are not cooperative.

Due to soil impacts above cleanup level, Ecology will add this property to the Contaminated Sites List.
