Dear Tom Mergy:

On August 20, 2024, the Department of Ecology (Ecology) provided a conditional approval of the pilot test work plan. Ecology has reviewed the revised memorandum titled "Pilot Test Work Plan – Amended 9/13/2024." This version addresses the conditions described earlier. Please add a professional license endorsement with signature to the first page and resubmit it. Ecology will need an electronic version and one hard copy.

Ecology is revising the agreed order schedule to accommodate the performance of the pilot test. Phase 1, completed in 3rd Quarter 2024, supports the design of the surfactant component of the remedial action. Phase 2 will collect data that will inform the contingent remedy (bioventing or soil vapor extraction).

The schedule is revised to allow completion of Phase 2 in the 4th Quarter 2024. The submittal of the draft EDR will be shifted to 1st Quarter 2025, as shown below. The remainder of the deliverables will adhere to the existing schedule in Agreed Order DE 23182.
