Farallon Consulting, L.L.C. has prepared the following Fourth Quarter 2024 Progress Report on behalf of The Estate of Barbara J. Nelson and WCN GST Non-Exempt Marital Trust No. 2 for the Thompson Field Gunshy Manor Site (Thompson Field Site) located in the vicinity of 420 196th Avenue Northeast in Redmond, Washington. The Thompson Field Site is listed with Cleanup Site ID 15285 and was assigned Washington State Department of Ecology (Ecology) Expedited VCP Project ID XN0021.

Description and status of Site characterization or cleanup work (completed during past quarter or ongoing work).

 Ecology reviewed and approved the Construction Stormwater General Permit to allow proposed excavation to begin, with the permit coverage effective October 22, 2024. However, excavation activities have been delayed pending the City of Redmond's reluctance to approve the work to be conducted during the wet season. The project has therefore been postponed until April 2025.

Excavation of contaminated soil at Thompson field scheduled for the fourth quarter of 2024 has now been delayed by the City of Redmond, with the anticipated start date of work in the second quarter 2025.
