The Department of Ecology has assessed a hazard ranking for your site at the southwest corner of Pacific Highway South and South 252nd Street, Kent, Washington, as required by the Model Toxics Control Act (Chapter 70.105D RCW). This ranking is an estimation of the potential threat of this site to human health and the environment, relative to other Washington State sites scored at this time. A ranking of 3 (with 1 being the highest risk and 5 being the lowest risk) has been calculated for your site.

For your information, Ecology will be publishing the ranking of this site and other sites in the August 27 Site Register. The rankings will be used in conjunction with other considerations in determining Ecology's priority for future action. It is not anticipated that this ranking will affect the current activities at this site.
