Dear Mr. Grohs:

You were notified previously of the hazard ranking assessed by the Department of Ecology (Ecology) for your property at the southwest corner of Pacific Highway South and South 252nd Street in Kent, Washington. This ranking represented an estimation of the potential threat posed by this site to human health and the environment, with 1 indicating the highest relative risk and 5 the lowest, out of a total of 255 sites assessed and ranked as of this date.

This database has now been enlarged by an additional eight-three (83) sites, resulting in changes in the relative rankings of some of the previously ranked sites. Your site was one of these, and it now has a hazard ranking of 4 instead of 3, as indicated in our earlier notification.

Ecology will be publishing the ranking of this and other sites in the August 25, 1992 Site Register. If you have any questions or need additional information, please contact Elaine Atkinson at (206) 649-7042.
