Transmittal of Ecology Comments on the *Site-Specific Terrestrial Ecological Evaluation*, dated April 30, 2010, Former Tacoma Metals Site, 1919 Portland Avenue, Tacoma, Washington, Agreed Order DE 97-5435.

Dear Dr. Fuji:

Based on our review of the above-referenced site-specific Terrestrial Ecological Evaluation (TEE) report, we find that it meets the intent of the TEE process set forth in the Model Toxics Control Act (MTCA), WAC 173-340-7490. The report assesses the risks to wildlife receptors from the site contaminants using the site-specific ecological indicator soil concentrations. The proposed soil cap in conjunction with the institutional controls has been adequately demonstrated to be protective of ecological receptors.

Therefore, the overall conclusions regarding ecological risks found at the site are valid and a paved cap will prevent exposure to soils exceeding the Table 749-3 values. The presumptive remedy will be protective of terrestrial ecological receptors from exposure to soil contaminants. The pavement will need to be maintained and proper institutional controls and environmental covenants will need to be used. Effectively, paving the property is considered a long-term interim action since contaminants exceeding the screening values will be left in place.

An evaluation of risks from sediment contamination from other exposure pathways was not addressed in the TEE report. Ecology is currently reviewing a proposed groundwater investigation work plan to define the extent of groundwater contamination that could potentially affect sediments.
