Dear Zak:

As previously discussed with you in our meeting on February 26, 2025 meeting, and based on data from ongoing groundwater sampling of the two newly installed downgradient monitoring wells, MW-13 and MW-14, the contaminated groundwater plume of the vinyl chloride (VC) is still not well defined at the downgradient extent, where VC is still detected in MW-13 above cleanup levels. An additional downgradient monitoring well is needed to delineate the extent of VC in groundwater. PBS proposes installing a new groundwater monitoring well east of 6<sup>th</sup> Avenue in the right-of-way as shown on attached Figure 1.

It is our understanding that Ecology supports the installation of a new groundwater monitoring well because it is expected to support delineation of the downgradient extent of the contaminated groundwater plume as part of the remedial investigation.




