Good morning Larry,

I pulled the site file this morning and updated the file to reflect the groundwater monitoring you are currently doing. I forgot that last Monday was a holiday and training the next two days, crazy week.

In the file I see a response to one of our letters that was sent by Joe Crossland from David Mendenhall, Sr. Water Quality Engineer and he is requesting a "No Further Action" status or even a change in the required amount of sampling & testing as Longview Fibre does not intend to do any further removal of soils as any contamination that still exists is under the building & inaccessible, dated March 4, 2003 address to John Bails.

My response to that is, Longview Fibre is currently doing the minimum amount of sampling by only testing the groundwater monitoring wells annually. The current status of this site is monitoring and for now that is the best we can do without additional sampling, etc. being done at the site.

For this site to obtain a "No Further Action" status, hiring a consultant would be in your best interest, they could fill out the forms, etc and a minimum of four consecutive quarters of groundwater monitoring results below the Model Toxic Control Act (MTCA) Method A Cleanup levels for Diesel, etc. would need to be achieved.

Ecology is making an effort to try to get sites moved into the "No Further Action" status by having property owners apply to our Voluntary Cleanup Program (VCP). This site could get a NFA status with contamination left on site with restrictions, for example a NFA with a deed restriction. That determination is strictly up to the site manager assigned to Longview Fibre.

Something to think about. I will include the link for the Voluntary Cleanup Program.

Thank you for sending me the groundwater results for your site. I will pull the site file on Monday.

I miss spoke about the cleanup levels for TPH-D/Oil, the cleanup levels for diesel and oil in groundwater are 500 ppb (parts per billion). Just from a quick glance the wells are still above the MTCA Method A cleanup levels.

I will call you on Monday after I pull the file and do a quick review.

Carrie (did i spell that right?), thank you for helping me this morning. Attached is what I have regarding the sampling we do. Also attached is a site plan sketch for well reference. When reviewing the sampling results, be advised that CAS reports in ug/L (ppb) so you need to move that pesky decimal point to the left! The numbers look much better then, and well below your (I believe you said) 500 ppm (mg/L). For points of reference on the site map, report references to the West parking lot would be well #3, north parking lot would be well #2. In review of a spreadsheet I just found going back to 1999, we have only sampled at those 2 wells.
