On behalf of Weyerhaeuser NR Company ("Weyerhaeuser"), I write to acknowledge receipt of your letter dated March 18, 2025, regarding the WA State Department of Ecology's ("Ecology's") preliminary determination of potential liability for release of hazardous substances at Weyerhaeuser Snoqualmie Mill, 38800 SE Mill Pond Rd, Snoqualmie, WA 98065; cleanup site ID 10346, facility/site ID 73953138 (the "Snoqualmie Site"). Weyerhaeuser does not have reason to dispute the basic facts in your letter and, without admitting any liability, accepts its status as a potentially liable person ("PLP") for the Snoqualmie Site.
