At the request of ExxonMobil Environmental and Property Solutions, on behalf of ExxonMobil Oil Corporation (ExxonMobil) and American Distributing Company (ADC), Stantec Consulting Services Inc. (Stantec) conducts environmental activities at the ExxonMobil ADC site (Site). Stantec prepared this *Cost Estimate for Compliance Monitoring Plan*, dated April 9, 2025, at the request of the Washington State Department of Ecology (Ecology).

In accordance with the Consent Decree, an estimate of all costs associated with the operation and maintenance of the remedial action at the Site, including institutional controls, compliance monitoring, and corrective measures, must be provided to Ecology within sixty (60) days of the completion of the remedial action. This is a budgetary estimate that represents the current cost of the work scope as described in Stantec's *Compliance Monitoring Plan*, dated April 9, 2025 for the Site (Stantec, 2025).

An estimate of costs associated with the operation and maintenance of the remedial action at the Site, including institutional controls, compliance monitoring, and corrective measures, is provided in Table 1. The budgetary estimate is broken down by year of work completion, tasks within that year, and subtasks

for clarity. Sales tax is generally not applicable to the tasks and subtasks included in this budgetary estimate with the exception of tasks associated with drilling contractors (well installation and soil sampling). This budgetary estimate was compiled without considering the effects of inflation or the time value of money (discounting for net present value). Future annual revisions to this budgetary estimate, in accordance with the Consent Decree, will either incorporate Ecology's Inflation Factor or be revised task by task using updated costs from subcontractors.

Additionally, with the exception of subtasks for potential asphalt repairs in Years 10, 20, 30, 40, and 50, no contingency is reflected in this budgetary estimate. The work scope as described in the *Compliance Monitoring Plan* for the Site (Stantec, 2025) is a fixed scope and will not grow over time. In fact, the work scope is expected to shrink over time as natural attenuation works to reduce petroleum hydrocarbon concentrations in soil and groundwater across the site and sampling locations are selectively eliminated from the sampling regimen upon meeting cleanup standards. Elimination of sampling locations over time will produce a greater cost savings than the Ecology-recommended contingency. Further, this budgetary estimate is subject to annual review and update in accordance with the Consent Decree, providing regular opportunities to revise costs for unforeseen changes.

A summary of the yearly totals and anticipated work scopes for that year is provided below. Details of costs associated with individual tasks and subtasks within each year is provided in Table 1.
