Re: Ecology Support for the Evergreen Treatment Services' Application for a Brownfields Cleanup Grant

Dear Becca Judy:

The Washington Department of Ecology (Ecology) acknowledges that Evergreen Treatment Services (ETS) plans to conduct the cleanup of a brownfield site and is applying for an FY25 EPA Brownfields Cleanup Grant.

ETS has developed an application requesting site-specific federal Brownfields Cleanup funding for the Evergreen Treatment Services site located at 1700 Airport Way South in Seattle.

Ecology affirms that the Evergreen Treatment Services site:

- I. Is eligible to be enrolled in the State voluntary response program;
- II. Is not currently enrolled, but ETS intends to enroll the site in the voluntary response program;
- III. Additional assessment is needed to sufficiently characterize the site for the remediation work to begin. There will be a sufficient level of site characterization from the environmental site assessment(s) performed by June 15, 2025, for the remediation work to begin on the site.
