Thank you so much for your patience these past couple weeks. The new year has been exceptionally busy for us, but we are doing our best to keep at it!

Unfortunately, I will not have the opinion issued in time for your drilling next week.

However, I have been able to go through the Draft Work Plan in greater detail since early January and feel that a sound investigation and monitoring strategy have been laid out. The 4 proposed monitoring well locations seem adequate given the release, and they seem positioned at the source and down/cross-gradient of the release, based on previous excavation sampling detections. As noted in Section 3.4 of the Draft Work Plan, if concentrations remain above cleanup levels, additional site investigation may be recommended.

Based on this information, I will continue to move forward with a neutral opinion response to the Draft Work Plan and we will look forward to the quarterly sampling results over the next year.
