Farallon Consulting, L.L.C. (Farallon) has prepared this progress report to document work performed for the Memorial Field (MF) and Rainier Trail (RT) Site in the Lower Issaquah Valley, Washington. This progress report summarizes work performed between March 1, 2025 and March 28, 2025 under One Time Grant Program Agreement No. OTGP-2025-Issaqu-00085 (Grant Agreement) between the Washington State Department of Ecology (Ecology) and the City of Issaquah (the City).

ACTIVITIES CONDUCTED DURING THE REPORTING PERIOD

This progress report includes costs incurred by the City between March 1, 2025 and March 28, 2025. Work conducted under the Grant Agreement scope included:

- Coordination with Ecology and Potentially Liable Persons (PLPs) regarding remedial investigation activities under the Agreed Order.
- Preparation of the Draft Remedial Investigation Work Plan (RIWP) annotated outline, including preparation of draft figures and tables. Finalization and submittal of existing boring logs to Ecology.
- Coordination for submitting existing data to Ecology's Environmental Information Management (EIM) database.
- Coordination for progress reporting and cost submittals to Ecology.
- Issued formal change of project coordinator letter to update PLP Project Coordinator per Ecology's request.
- Coordination with Ecology and PLPs regarding Washington State Department of Health Fact Sheet.

CHANGES IN KEY PERSONNEL

The PLP Project Coordinator was updated to Sarah Snyder per Ecology's request.



DEVIATIONS FROM APPROVED SCOPE OF WORK

There were no deviations from the approved scope of work.

SCHEDULE

No deviations from the project schedule were identified, with the exception of an extension to Ecology's review of the Annotated RIWP outline. An updated project schedule is attached.

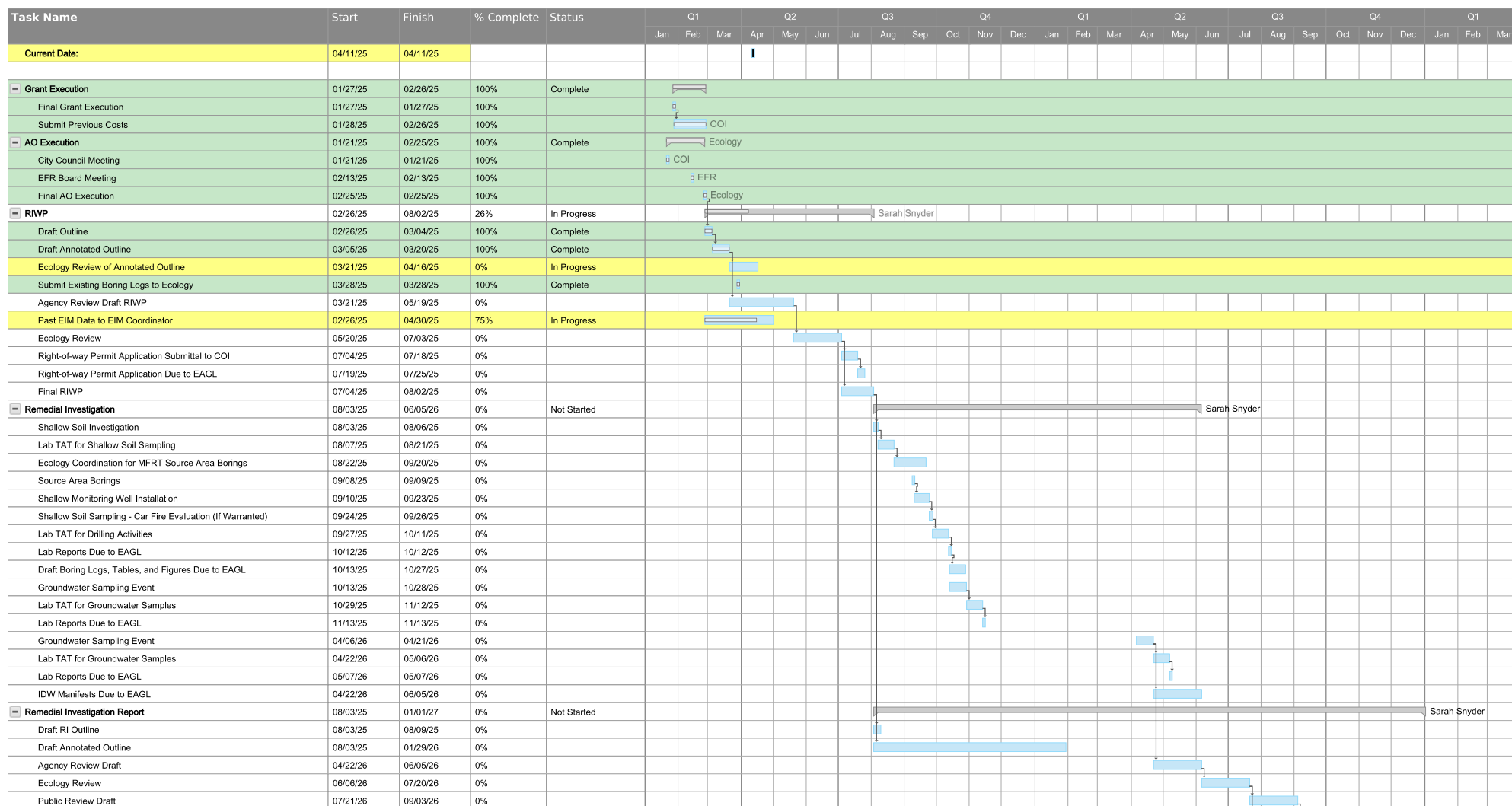
