Arcadis has prepared this Cleanup Progress Report on behalf of Univar Solutions USA, LLC (Univar Solutions) to summarize site remediation activities performed at the Univar Solutions facility located at 8201 South 212<sup>th</sup> Street in Kent, Washington (site). This progress report covers the period from January 1 through June 30, 2025 (reporting period).

This report is being submitted pursuant to the requirements of Agreed Order No. DE 5988 (AO) between Univar Solutions (formerly Univar USA, Inc.) and the Washington State Department of Ecology (Ecology), effective November 20, 2008. Pursuant to Task 4, Exhibit B of the AO, this report includes:
