Work hours are from 8 am to 6 pm, Monday through Friday

What to expect:

- **More truck traffic** in the neighborhood and along truck haul routes (i.e., by work areas and along N 3rd Avenue).
- **Loud construction noise** during work hours.
- **Restricted access** to right-of-way areas.
- Possible **parking disruptions**.
- **Construction equipment** and clean bulk materials laydown area (blue area on map on the back of this postcard).



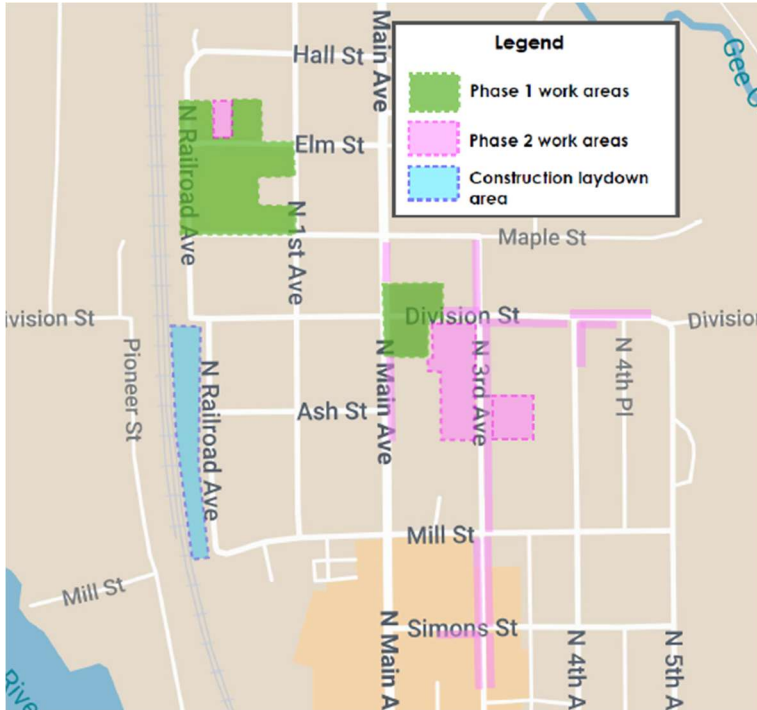
Please call Jack Donahue immediately if you see dust in the air off the worksite, or dirt/dust being tracked off the worksite.
