## Site history

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The Site has operated as an outdoor firing range since 1947. The locations of the shotgun range, located in the central portion of the Site, and the rifle and pistol range, located in the northern and eastern portions of the Site. The current configuration of the shotgun range includes seven traps that launch clay targets over an open field. Debris from broken and unbroken clay targets was present on the ground surface primarily in a fan-shaped arc approximately 125 to 225 feet downrange (east) of each trap. The rifle and pistol range has berms on the eastern, western, and northern sides that serve as backstops for bullets fired during target shooting by GHSC patrons. Lead reclamation was completed at the Site in 2011 to remove lead shot from the ground surface of the shotgun range and the wooded area east of the shotgun range.
