Dear Tom Graham:

Ecology has received your updated Work Plan for Stormwater System Cleanout prepared by SLR and dated July 18, 2025. That document updated an earlier version dated May 9, 2025, and incorporated Ecology comments from an email dated May 12, 2025.

Ecology requests that you proceed with the stormwater system cleanout work as soon as possible. The Work Plan includes line closures and outfall abandonment activities. Such line closures and outfall abandonment activities should be conducted in coordination with the consultants for W&W Everett Investments LLC (Floyd Snider and KPFF).

Ecology requests that we be kept informed of the stormwater system cleanout work. Ecology should be notified within 48 hours of any identified concerns that could have a bearing on contamination migration. The work should be documented within a detailed technical memorandum document to be submitted to Ecology. That technical memorandum should include photographic documentation of the cleanout work as well as receipts documenting proper disposal of removed materials.
