6	PLP to Submit Agency Review Draft Sampling and Analysis Plan and Quality Assurance Project Plan, both specific to Groundwater Monitoring	By September 15, 2025
6	Quarterly Groundwater Monitoring	Every 3 months, commencing within 45 days of Ecology approval of the Groundwater Monitoring Sampling and Analysis Plan and Quality Assurance Project Plan
6	PLP to Submit Draft Quarterly Groundwater Monitoring Reports, as described in Task 6	Quarterly; 45 days after PLP receives complete analytical report from the laboratory

6	PLP to Submit Revised Quarterly Groundwater Monitoring Reports	30 days after PLP receives Ecology comments on draft Quarterly Groundwater Monitoring Report
6	PLP to Submit Final Quarterly Groundwater Monitoring Report	15 days after Ecology's approval of revised Quarterly Groundwater Monitoring Report
